





## SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMME IN BIOLOGY STPIB-2019

Science City, Chennai - 600 025, The Academy of Sciences, Chennai - 600025, & Centre for Advanced Studies in Botany, University of Madras Guindy Campus, Chennai - 600 025.

The Academy of Sciences and the Centre for Advanced Studies in Botany, University of Madras, will jointly conduct a Summer Training Programme in Biology (STPIB-2019) for about three weeks  $(28^{th} \text{ May} - 17^{th} \text{ June}, 2019)$  and it is sponsored by the Science City of the Government of Tamil Nadu. This course is meant for the **first year M.Sc. Biology students** (going to the second year in July 2019) who are interested in pursuing a research career. The course will consist of lectures and laboratory work. The lectures will be delivered by the faculty members drawn from the leading research and teaching institutions in and around Chennai.

The programme is open to all the P.G. institutions in Tamil Nadu. Since not more than thirty students will be selected for the course, the admission will normally be restricted to two students per Department/College.

The outstation participants will be paid second class train fare by the shortest route. Steps are being taken to provide hostel accommodation with free boarding and lodging for the outstation participants.
